

Join the Lake Berryessa Shoreline Clean-Up

Lake Berryessa users are invited to clean up the trash on the shoreline on <u>Saturday</u>, <u>May 19th</u>, the weekend before the big Memorial Day Weekend rush. Volunteers can show up with their boats, PWCs, kayaks, canoes, or on foot, at one of 4 checkin locations around the lake.

The Lake Berryessa Shoreline Clean-Up will run from 9:00 AM until Noon, with check-in starting at 8:30 AM. After checking in, PWC, Boat, Paddle, & Hiking groups will be given maps and sent out to different parts of the lake, depending on how accessible the shoreline area is. Participants are encouraged to preregister so organizers can make sure there are enough volunteers at each station.

Prizes donated by local businesses will be given out in each zone for the Most Unique & Largest pieces of trash, and to whomever fills the most bags. Be sure to bring your digital camera or cameraphone so you can take pictures as proof. This First Annual Shoreline Clean-Up is sanctioned & supported by our local Bureau of Reclamation office, and coordinated by local businesses & community groups.

The Bureau of Reclamation has released its official announcement regarding the Pope Creek Bridge Waterway closures. It generated much negative response - one letter typical of the many comments heard is printed below.

However, as of our deadline on Monday, April 30th, the BOR said that since they do not yet have the required signs and buoys, the Big Island Lagoon/Smittle Creek area will not be closed to motorized watercraft this recreation season.

Lake Berryessa's Pope Creek Waterway Closed on Major Holidays

The Bureau of Reclamation announces that beginning Memorial Day weekend the Pope Creek Bridge waterway, located at Lake Berryessa, will be closed to all motorized and non-motorized watercraft. This closure will occur again for the July 4th holiday weekend and Labor Day holiday weekend. Re-opening of the area to watercraft will be reinstated after each holiday weekend.

Reclamation and the Napa County Sheriffs Office are working together to prevent unsafe conditions which result from thousands of visitors congregating on holiday weekends at the Pope Creek Bridge water area. Overcrowding on boats, near-drownings, disorderly conduct, offensive behavior, underage drinking, and assaults have occurred. Major injuries and several deaths have resulted from people jumping off the high rocks and Pope Creek Bridge. It is illegal to jump off the bridge and violators will be cited. There are signs posted warning visitors not to jump off the bridge or rocks. The closed area will be designated by buoys. The gates at Pope Creek parking lot will be closed and locked at 10 p.m. The closure will assist Reclamation and the Napa County Sheriffs Office in ensuring a safe and secure area on holiday weekends.

This closure is effective: Memorial Day Weekend from 1 p.m. on Thursday, May 24, 2007, to 3 p.m. on Tuesday, May 29, 2007 Independence Day Week from 1 p.m. on Thursday, June 28, 2007, to 3 p.m. on Tuesday, July 10, 2007 Labor Day Weekend from 1 p.m. on Thursday, August 30, 2007, to 3 p.m. on Tuesday, September 4, 2007

Each major holiday, the police even have a "Critical Response" unit in place, so why can't they use it as intended and maintain peace and order?

You are also penalizing local residents like myself, who use the area for fishing and for entertaining friends and family who come for the holiday periods. It seems to me that instead of trying to solve problems that may arise, you are just creating a hostile environment that may result in even more problems in another area. Do you really believe that boaters are just going to stay away, and not just move to another area such the Putah Creek bridge? If you do you are being very naïve!

Martin Family 100th Anniversary Party in Winters

Winters will be the site of a Martin family gathering to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the arrival of the first ship of Spanish immigrants to Hawaii.

April 26 marked the anniversary of the first ship, the S.S. Heliopolis, which brought 2,246 men, women and children from Malaga, Spain, to Hawaii to harvest the sugar cane crop. Eventually, nearly 90 percent of the Spanish immigrants relocated to California, including the Martin family who established their home in Winters.

The voyage, which took 47 days, included passengers Mr. and Mrs. Antonio Melendez. Martin and their five children; Antonio G. Martin, Maria G. Martin, Francisco G. Martin, Juan G. Martin and Jose G. Martin. Emilio G. Martin and Miguel G. Martin were born in Hawaii and Carmen G. Martin was born in Winters.

I got to the lake on Friday afternoon and it felt like the middle of summer. I headed out by myself and started fishing the wall on the left side going towards Capell Cove. In about thirty-five feet of water I cast towards the shore line which was loaded with fallen trees and picked up some nice largemouth bass. I was using my favorite River2Sea crawdad with Procure crawdad gel.

On Saturday I set out early and went into my favorite cove. The fish seemed like they were on the bite no matter where you fished. Later in the morning I picked my wife up and we decided to try our luck near the Ranch house. Boat traffic was pretty heavy in that area which produced alot of waves and made it a bit difficult

for us to fish the way we like to. I managed to get a few bites and landed two nice size bass but my wife had no luck. After a while she decided to go in. I dropped her off and went back to my favorite cove near Steele Park and spent the rest of the afternoon and evening there. It was a three quarter moon and a very pleasant evening. It seemed like the bass were going for anything I was throwing.





I taught them how to feel the bottom and Jason got a hit and landed a nice spotted bass. We fished a few different spots in that area and both boys were doing well. At one point we changed to weightless senkos and fished a shallow rocky area and the bass were just hitting one after another. 

The Berryessa Family Reunion is May 19 at Berryessa Marina Resort Early California Berryessa Family History by Christine Bonner

In September of 1775, Nicolas Antonio Berryessa and his sister Maria Isabel, my first California ancestors, began their long journey to California from Mexico. Unhappy over the arrival of a new stepmother, they wanted a chance to get away, so they marched under the flag with Captain Juan Bautista de Anza and the Spanish Colonization Expedition. They settled in the San Francisco area, thus beginning the early history of the Berryessa family.

Nicolas and other Spanish-Mexican families began to establish their ranchos after receiving Spanish land grants. Following Mexican Independence in 1822 from Spain, the Mexican Colonization Law of 1824 insured the early settlers clear title to unoccupied lands, allowing many other families to join the Berryessas in California's heartland.

In May 1846, the United States declares war on Mexico with the intent of acquiring Texas and California. In California, most of the fighting occurred in the south. Without clear direction from Congress, Captain John C. Fremont's men captured Sutter's Fort without a battle. Also without a fight, four Berryessa brothers, Francisco, Nemesio, Santiago and Santos, along with General Mariano Guadalupe Vallejo and other Californianos, were taken prisoner by the Bear Flaggers, who wanted to declare an independent Republic of California.

Fremont appeared to be supporting the rebels, or using them to foment war in Northern California. In the confusion, Jose de los Reyes Berryessa, a worried father at the age of 75, left his San Vicente hacienda to visit his imprisoned sons. Two of his nephews, Francisco and Ramon de Haro accompanied him. Unarmed, they were intercepted by Fremont and his scout Kit Carson, and killed.

To the peaceful Northern Californians, some of whom had favored a United States takeover of California, it was cold-blooded murder. A prominent San Francisco surveyor who was an eyewitness to the killings ultimately claimed Berryessa land as his own.

The Bear Flag Republic never materialized and Captain Fremont was summoned to the east under cloud of a court martial. Nonetheless, the United States won the war and acquired California, and under the Treaty of Guadalupe-Hidalgo, Mexican residents were to retain their land grants and enjoy full citizenship. But it was not to be.

As gold lured hordes of wealth-seekers from the states, bigotry, violence, and discrimination in the courts robbed many Mexican Californians of their property and lives. Squatters wanted the land and were determined to have it. Many members of Nicolas Berryessa's family died trying to protect their ranchos.

Years after California became a state in 1850, the battle over land continued. Holders of Mexican land grants were required to bear the burden of proof of ownership, which meant they paid the legal fees for long court maneuvers and expensive land surveys-challenge after challenge. When at last they couldn't pay, the native Californians were forced from their land. For families like the Berryessas, it was the end of a dream in the new land of California.


