Two Large Fires Here

Last Wednesday was a hot one - in more ways than one - when a large grass fire endangered subdivision homes, and a large dock complex and five boats burned at a resort.

At 12:57 P.M. on Wednesday afternoon, 53 firefighters from the California Division of Forestry and Napa County were summoned to battle a blaze which was believed started just behind Steele Park Resort by youngsters playing with matches.

A strong breeze quickly spread the flames into the Berryessa Highlands subdivision, blistering the home of Leo Nelson on Steele Canyon Road, and coming very close to several other residences in the area.

Fortunately, quick action by residents with garden hoses, fast engine and equipment response, and accurate drops by the air tankers, no serious damage or injuries occurred, except possibly to the nerves of the homeowners!

Over sixty acres were burned before the fire was completely controlled at approximately 10 P.M. in the evening.

While things were really getting hot in the Highlands, another fire was started at Putah Creek Park Resort when a boat, belonging to Mel Liebelt of San Leandro, but being operated by Anthony Hernandez of Novato, caught fire after refueling at the gas dock and drifted

FISHING NEWS BY

MIKE CREAM

Lake Berryessa continues to set the pace, as limits are common in most fish species.

Trout, Bass, Crappie and Catfish are all being hooked, and the kids are being passified with red worms and Blue Gill.

Rainbows and Browns are cruising at depths of 25 to 50 feet. Pink Lady trolling device, lead line, sinker releases, weights or downriggers are the methods being used to reach the depths now. Top lures include Dick Nite Spoon, Andy Reekers, Triple Teaser, Neeidle Fish and Z-Ray. Top trolling zones are in 100 feet of water, so fish deep. Trollers should troll over the old creek bed, from the tip of Big Island to The Narrows, and the Spanish Flat Pump House, across to The Narrows.

Race are rated good, early mornings and evenings. Boat to shore plug casting in most major coves, rocky ledges, or creeks is best. Surface lures like Rebel, Devil's Horse, Hulla Popper, Lucky 13 or Bomber Spin Stick or Bomber Spin Stick are all good early and late. Mid-day Bassers should go to 1/4 ounce Spinner Baits.

Crappie are thick - Fish heavy brush and sunken trees in coves and creeks. Minnow, Bravley's Crappie Jig or Mimi Jig are best. Check at the marinas for top cover.

Catfish are also in cover areas. You should take Cats where you find Crappie - just drop to the bottom.

Blue Gill are around Marinas and launching areas. Salmon Eggs or Red Worms, on a No. 12 hook is your set up.



SPANISH FLAT RESORT NEWS

Lake Berryessa is not so very far from civilization - only 25 - 30 miles from the nearest towns. But, when you go over the grade from Napa, or come up Interstate 80 and Wooden Valley, you get into a part of the country that looks and feels very different from the Napa Valley and the Bay Area. You feel you are far away in the mountains, and you can relax and forget about every day worries and strains.

As a matter of fact, we're so "remote" that one of the residents in Spanish Flat Mobile Villa, Lucchesi, met what she thou-

ght was a mountain lion on her walk around the Loop Road a couple of weeks ago! She was just as surprised as it was, and it disappeared quickly from her sight, up the hill. They are not fond of people.

We noticed, at about the same time, the remains of a couple of dead fawns not far from there. The buzzards were circling around and cleaned up the job of whoever or whatever killed them. It could have been a mountain lion, or a big bobcat.

Also, the coyotes are getting braver these nights, but it's doubtful that they would attack a fawn of any size. We often hear their eerie songs up in the hills during the night. But now, when the Manzanita berries are getting ripe, they are coming closer and closer to the house. The other morning I noticed their "calling card" on a flat rock by a faucet, only about 150 feet from the house.

TOO MUCH CAFFEIN?

More than half of all Americans over the age of nine drink large quantities of coffee and other caffeinated drinks despite studies linking caffeine to birth defects, according to a recent issue of Environmental Nutrition newsletter.

Of those who drink coffee, the most highly caffeinated beverage, the publication says about 23 percent have five or more cups per day. This puts them well over the recommended daily limit of 200 milligrams, the amount of caffeine in just one 8-ounce cup of coffee.

Most health professionals recommend moderation in the use of caffeinated products like coffee, cola drinks and tea. One easy way to avoid overconsumption of such beverages is to select nutritional,

CONTINUED FROM PAGE 1, COLUMNS 4 & 5 into another dock, containing four boats tied up in wet storage.

Not only was the Kona-Jet boat operated by Hernandez destroyed, but all four of the other boats were totally burned and sank. One of the burned vessels belonged to the resort, the other four to customers.

According to the CDF, total estimated damage was \$32,000 - \$10,000 to the dock system, and \$22,000 to the boats. (See the photo on Page 1.)

CDF claimed the extensive destruction was due to the fire burning a good ten minutes before it was reported, then another 14 minutes before an engine could get to the scene. No injuries were reported.



LAKE PATROL ACTION

Hot weather resulted in many boaters on the lake over the weekend and the Lake Patrol reports they issued 29 Verbal Warnings and 10 Citations. They performed dock and boat fire at Putah Creek, reported on Page 1.

HELPFUL HINT
FOR THE WEEK: PREVENTING BOAT GASOLINE FIRES - All motorboats using gasoline for fuel must have adequate ventilation. Engine and fuel compartments must be vented with at least two ventalator ducts fitted with cowls.

Many boat explosions occur shortly after fueling. Caution should be used by the operator during fueling operations, and each time the engine is started.

Best means of checking for explosive gasoline fumes is to use your nose, sniffing any compartment in which fumes could collect. IT COULD SAVE YOUR LIFE!!

WITH CLAUDE DAVIS

At Markley Cove Resort, nearly all fishermen and the management wish to give the Department of Fish and Game a big vote of thanks for the great job of taking care of the Trout Program!

This year has been a terrific trout year, due to the planting of Eagle Lake Trout. These trout are real scrapers, and are growing real fast. Also, they are easily caught.

Most of us who fish a lot feel we are going to have the best trout harvest of all time!

We all especially thank Bob Rawstron, formerly "the Fish and Game Biologist for Lake Berryessa," and now the Management Supervisor for the Yountville office of the Department of Fish and Game, for rescuing us. The low water years put a damper on the fishing at Lake Berryessa, but all is very good once again, thanks to Bob.

Small shad minnows are showing in the stomachs of the trout now, and easy limits are the rule. Just get down 25 to 50 feet with a big variety of lures, and a little time will make a successful fishing trip.

Bigger fish are coming in now, and fishing for trout is very good.

Ken Rettig, Buster Hertzberg, and yours truly, all fish several times each week, and find the pink and white Andy Reeker #0 to be a "RED HOT" lure for catching trout.

We all find very easy limits using our Big Jon Downriggers and 25 to 50 feet seems to be the best depths.

Early A.M. we get many trout at 25 feet down, and then as the day gets brighter, the trout go deeper.

Big trout are coming from The Narrows, and it will only be a few days and the dam area will have lots of big trout. That is the pattern for the last ten years, according to my fishing diary.

For those who may be interested, I have kept every fishing trip in my diary for ten years, and it helps me a lot. If there are any specific dates you are interested in, just let me know . . .

TREE SQUIRREL SEASON OPENS IN FIVE COUNTIES

Tree squirrel hunting season in five San Francisco Bay area counties opened Saturday.

August 2nd, the Department of Fish and Game said in a reminder issued today. The counties are Marin, Napa, Solano and Sonoma, and that part of Lake County outside of Mendocino National Forest.

Daily bag and possession limit for the season, which will run through January 25, 1981, is four.

The general tree squirrel hunting season will open September 13th, and also run through January 25th, with the same bag and possession limit.

Also opening on August 2nd was the archery and falconary tree squirrel hunting season in 25 California counties and a portion of a 26th. The season will continue through September 12th, with a daily limit of four in bag and possession.


